### Austrian band happy to be rocking all over the world

A MODERN rock band has travelled from Austria to perform at Old Nick's Tavern.

Cornerstone will play at the Horncastle pub at 9pm tomorrow.

The power pop indie band, who have an undercurrent of 1980s music, will rock the stage with Patricia Hillinger singing, Michael Wachelhofer on bass and keyboard, Steve Wachelhofer on guitar and Mike Pawlowitsch on drums.

Last summer, Cornerstone worked with Atom records on their new CD *Somewhere In America* – inspired by the adventures of their 2009 USA tour.

Michael said: "Suddenly we had all those tracks which were like a story.

"I have to be careful with my choice of

words, because I'm always saying that our songs are all non-narrative.

"There's no beginning and no ending or a critical point which has to be solved in the song. If you want to call it a story, then it is a never-ending story."

They released their debut album *Head Over Heels* in 2008.

After that CD release, the band did numerous tours of Europe and America, headlining clubs and sharing large stages with acts such as John Waite (Babys, Bad English) and Iron Maiden's Dennis Stratton.

They also performed with Ted Poley from Danger, Danger and American singer-songwriter Jeffrey Gaines.

Cornerstone also participated in the

UK-based Z Rock Festival in 2009. Some of the songs from *Head Over Heels* were included in the motion-picture soundtrack for the film *Little Alien*.

The press has been extremely favourable to the band's blend of 1980s rock, mixed with a harder edge.

Powerplay Magazine said: "Head Over Heels is a slick piece of work, the singer has a wonderful voice and the band know how to make decent melodic rhythms, definitely enjoyable."
